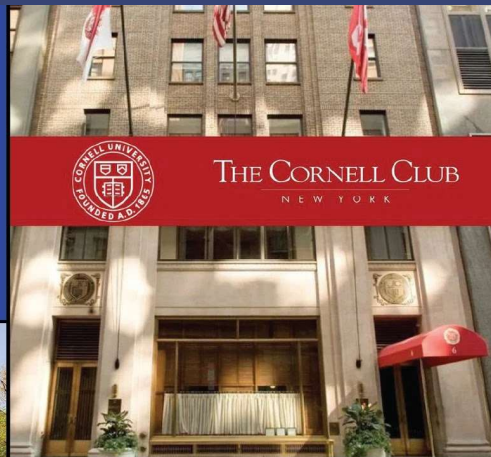


## Cornell Club Event Recap!

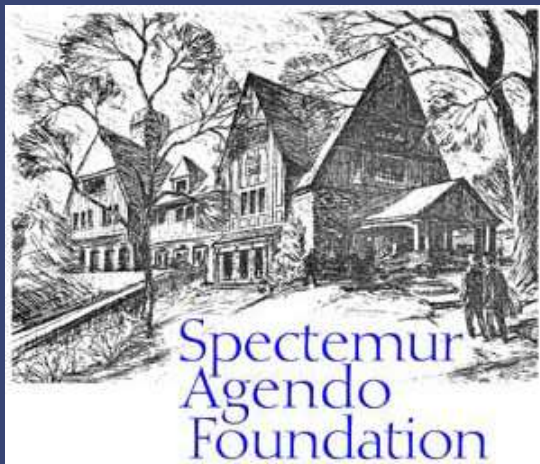
many years working under Patrick O'Connell, he has risen to the role of Culinary Director. Jules was also part of the Inn's team when it earned its first Michelin stars.
